

Printing from Photoshop 7 or CS & Mac OSX using the Epson 890, 1200, 1270 or 1290 printers with custom ICC Profiles.

1. Open Calibration image in Photoshop 7 or CS., but do not colour manage
2. Go to File/Print with Preview.
3. Click “Show more options” and select “Colour Management”
4. Under “Profile” select “**Same As Source**” from the pull down menu.
5. Click “Page Setup” and select A4 and Landscape, click “OK”
6. Click “Print” and then choose “Print Settings” from the 3rd pull down menu.
7. Set the “Media Type” to “**Photo Quality Glossy Film**”
8. Set the “Print Mode” to “Advanced Settings”
9. Set “Print Quality” to “Photo – 1440 dpi” and uncheck “High Speed”
10. Choose “Colour Management” from the 3rd pull down menu.
11. Select “**No Colour Adjustment**”
12. Click “Print”

N.B. In OSX 10.2.6 or above you can save the above settings by going to the “Presets” pull down menu, click “Save As” and enter suitable name.
